Our school would like to help those families who have been displaced in Syria, the Middle East and Africa. We are asking that our families help in the following ways:

- Each family is asked to send in a plastic/ziploc bag with toothbrush, toothpaste and bar of soap. (please send in by Monday 21st September)
- Support the collection taking place in St James's Hall for the next three Saturdays (starting September 19th) between 10am and 4pm. Good quality clothing, shoes and bedding items (sleeping bags –not duvets).
- Our school will be supporting GOAL on Jersey Day which takes place on Friday, October 9th. On this day all of the children are asked to wear their favourite jersey/t-shirt and make a contribution to GOAL who are also working to alleviate the refugees.

Arts, Crafts & Photocopying

The contribution for Arts, Crafts and Photocopying is **€40 per child**. This can be paid as one payment of **€40** before the end of September or two installments of **€20** (in September and January).

- A €10 reduction will apply to each 2nd and subsequent child in a family. (2 children €70; 3+ children €100)
- When sending this money into school please place it in an envelope and write your child's name on the envelope.
- Swimming will take place for six weeks for 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th classes commencing in February. There is a charge of €36 which will be collected at that time.

Attendance

Parents please note that the class roll call takes place first thing each morning. In order to ensure your child is not marked absent please have them in school on time or else please inform the school if your child will be absent for the day or part of the day.

If your child is absent please call the school office. You may also use the absence notes which you will find at the back of the homework diary.
